FYI... Céline Morali started saving lives in May, 1940 and continued through September, 1942. Approximately 300 Jewish refugees and prisoners of war escaping Nazi Germany made their way to her hardware store in Paris. They came in small groups, hiding either below the store in the basement or above it in the family living quarters. Her teenage daughter, Simone, practiced the piano to help mask the sound of hidden refugees. After a few days, they would leave in a truck driven by Alfred Fuhrman and were spirited over the border at Chalon-sûr-Saône to hiding places in the southern Zone.

Among those saved was the family of Emile Zenatti: son Claude, daughter Arlette, wife Lucie, and Lucie's sister Marietta Bloch. Arlette and Claude Zenatti were 11 and 13 years old at liberation. Their testimony resulted in Céline Morali posthumously receiving Yad Vashem's highest honor, Righteous Among the Nations, on June 29, 2015. The award ceremony will take place April 18, 2016 at 2:30 pm at the Memorial de la Shoah--17, rue Geoffroy L'Asnier, Paris. The public is invited.
