Worldwide **Holocaust Memorial Monument Database** Launched: Three research organizations join efforts to create a comprehensive inventory and history of Holocaust memorial monuments worldwide.

The digital database, *Holocaust Memorial Monuments* (cja.huji.ac.il/hmm/browser.php?mode=main) has been launched as a partnership project of the Center for Jewish Art, Hebrew University of Jerusalem; the Sue and Leonard Miller Center for Contemporary Judaic Studies/The George Feldenkreis Program in Judaic Studies, University of Miami, Florida; and the International Survey of Jewish Monuments, Syracuse, New York.

The new database – still in a developmental stage – has been created to collect and preserve digital documentation about Holocaust memorial monuments worldwide, including standardized mapping, photography, description, and historical research. It also includes a growing bibliography on Holocaust and memorial monuments.

UNESCO, in partnership with the **University of Southern California's Shoah Foundation**, the **American Federation of Teachers** and the **American Jewish Committee** launched a US-wide online professional training program for schoolteachers, superintendents and principals to address the antisemitism, the distortion and denial of the Holocaust in schools. Hosted jointly by UNESCO and the World Jewish Congress, the website www.aboutholocaust.org sets out the facts of the Holocaust in 19 languages, educating readers on the historical roots of the genocide, its processes, and consequences.
